



## **CODE OF CONDUCT**

Welcome to L.A. LIVE! L.A. LIVE is private property. The guidelines below are presented to encourage guests of L.A. LIVE to enjoy an orderly, respectful environment, but are by no means exhaustive. Failure to comply with these guidelines or with any reasonable order of identifiable L.A. LIVE officials and/or security guards in the performance of their duties may result in a request to leave L.A. LIVE or being banned from L.A. LIVE.

You agree not to engage in the following activities while visiting L.A. LIVE:

- Physical force or verbal threats.
- Possess or use any article defined or usable as a weapon, including but not limited to, firearms, clubs or sticks over ¼ inch in diameter, chemical dispensing devices, knives with blades over 2 inches in length, and any other object(s) that may be used in any way to inflict bodily injury.
- Intimidate or harass others.
- Interfere with the orderly conduct of business, operations of tenants, or L.A. LIVE security activities in any manner, or littering.
- Operate a moving conveyance, such as skateboards, bicycles, skates, etc., excluding wheelchairs, crutches and other similar conveyances necessary to assist individuals with disability or injury.
- Deface, damage, destroy or remove property of L.A. LIVE or its tenants or patrons, including but not limited to tables, chairs, trash receptacles, etc.
- Obstruct the free flow of vehicle or pedestrian traffic or violate the traffic laws, parking regulations or other vehicle or pedestrian traffic restrictions.
- Bring animals, except in the case of service or guide animals.
- Wear apparel that is obscene, libelous, or likely to provoke a conflict, or fail to be fully clothed.
- Possess, consume, sell, distribute or exchange alcohol beverages (except for consumption in designated areas) or controlled substances, or be under the influence of either.
- Smoking in non-designated areas.
- Violate any federal or state statute, local ordinance or L.A. LIVE policy.
- Willfully incite others to violate this Code or any federal or state statute, local ordinance, or L.A. LIVE policy.

**The following activities require pre-authorization from L.A. LIVE management:**

- Expressive Activity/Solicitation or distribution of promotional materials (NO flyers, pamphlets, brochures, etc)
- Commercial/Professional photography or filming
- Assembly—If you desire to engage in First Amendment free speech or expression, you may only do so pursuant to L.A. LIVE’s time, place, and manner restrictions regulating such activity.
